 Proof of U.S. citizenship for everyone applying Non-citizens may qualify for limited coverage through Indiana Health Coverage Programs.

☐ Proof of immigration status for everyone applying
 Alien registration card, permanent resident card, or other documentation from
the Bureau for Citizenship and Immigration Services
☐ Proof of money received by applicant, spouse, and dependent
children in home for the past 90 days
 Wages—pay stubs, paychecks, or statement from your employer for the past 90 days
 Termination notice—if loss of employment has occurred in the past 90 days
 Hire notice—if employment has been shorter than 90 days
 Self-employment—most recent, signed federal income tax return and
personally self-kept records of monthly income and expenses for the past 90 days
If new and have not filed taxes yet – self-kept records of
monthly income and expenses back to start date
 Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, disability,
sick pay, unemployment, or any other received benefits
 Financial aid award letter for current year—only if applicant is
currently enrolled in college
☐ Guardianship or Power of Attorney—provide documentation if someone
has legal authority to act on your behalf
☐ Insurance card (front and back) — for anyone that is applying and is
currently covered by another plan
